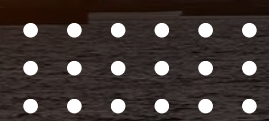

Risk Management & Sustainability

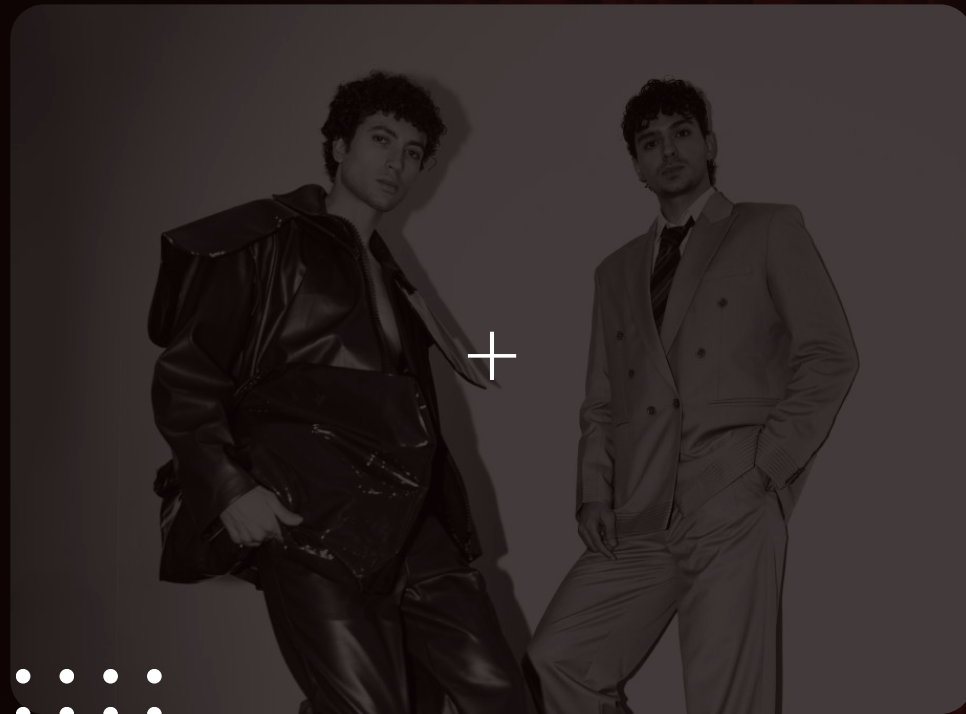
Potential Risks

- Low participation → Mitigation: Nationwide outreach, partnerships with gyms, sports clubs, universities.
- Media coverage shortfall → Mitigation: Pre-agreements with media and social media strategy.
- Environmental / weather challenges → Mitigation: Indoor venue contingency plans.

Sustainability Plan

- Annual event with increasing visibility and sponsorship.
- Permanent training programs for male talent in Reykjavik.
- Partnerships with fashion brands and international modeling agencies.
